## Mini Circuit Show Discussion:

- ❖ The Show will be June 18, 2022. The location will either be the Broken Bit Arena in Idaho Falls or The Snake River Arena in Blackfoot, both Indoor to protect from temperamental Idaho Weather. Shanetel will look into it and Tax Techs Inc will sponsor the arena. Location tabled until we can gather more information. Di said her Tax business is still willing to Sponsor the Judge Fees, Locaion Fees, Prize Fees, and anything else up to \$3,000.00 to help the show.
- ❖ DeShone Appaloosas will donate the \$100.00 added money and it will be run same as years past.
- ❖ We discussed the need to have Hores Classes so the Horse can collect the points for an open horse award.
- ❖ We discussed people Barb has spoken to for necessary positions for the show
- ❖ Di mentioned knowing a potential caterer for the event if the location allows for one
- ❖ Barb has been trying to get ahold of Becky Crapo in order to discuss CISHA participation in the show. So far she has had no success.
- ❖ Kim brought up that if CISHA does participate, we should include their \$2.00 Increase to all shows to prevent any problems in sign-ups
- ❖ We discussed the fact that when we put on a show, we use the ApHC Show Rules as the 'Guidelines'! Barb

- ❖ Will offer Five High point awards (youth walk/trot 11& under, youth 13&under, outh 14-17, registered Appaloosa horse and Open horse)
- ❖ Class list lightly gone over but won't be confirmed until we decide about CIHSA participation.
