



# Minutes of Intermountain Appaloosa Horse Club

Treasurer Report:

- Current Balance as of date \$5,585.69 no outstanding balance
- The YTD Profit & Loss is a Gain of \$2,845.07
- The June 18, 2022 Profit & Loss shows a Gain of \$1,972.74 with only the transactions between Barb and the club unreconciled
- The Raffle Total was \$400

## **OLD BUSINESS**

Part of the Treasurer Report: The Photographer donated the pictures and slide shows to the Club to sale/use as we need. We do not know what to charge. Barb suggests Di ask the photographer what the normal rate is so we can gage a fair price. Barb described that normally the photos are stamped by the Artis and are expensive.

- ❖ Two ideas: We can either charge a cover charge, (flat rate), fee to let Exhibitors review all photos and then just charge the printing fees or
- ❖ We can charge three to ten over the printing price per picture

Note that this meeting was originally scheduled for July 14. More than one Director had scheduling conflicts so we all agreed to move it to the 21<sup>st</sup>.

EISF Show:

- ❖ Di reported: The EISF will pay the Premiums of the Show and up to \$200 for the Judge
- ❖ Di offered for Tax Techs Inc to Sponsor the Show and the IApHC to Host it. What she means by this is that the show will not cost the Club anything, but if there is a profit, the Club gets it.
- ❖ Barb clarified that if the points of this show are to qualify for the IApHC Year-End Awards then the ByLaws have to be met. The Requirements are:
  - Must have at least one Halter Class
  - Must have four Performance Classes
- ❖ Di reported that she is only willing to put together Saturday morning for the Show. She does not have enough help or time to do any more than that. With this said, we discussed the following POSSIBLE class List:
